### Year 5 make a great start to new term



The children have had a fantastic start to the year and have settled in to Year 5 well.

During the Autumn term we concentrate on number within our Maths lessons. The children have continued to develop their place value, multiplication, division, addition and subtraction skills. In addition the children have also learnt new mathematical concepts such as factors,

prime number, square numbers and cubed numbers.

In Science, the children learnt about the reproduction of plants and really enjoyed dissecting flowers in order to find the male and female parts. We are now learning about life cycles and comparing the life cycles of mammals, insects, birds and amphibians.

Many of the children have made massive strides in

their swimming recently. Miss Allen and Mr McGovern are both really impressed!

Geography, the children learnt about the different countries South America, with a focus on Peru. Thev compared the city of Lima to the Wirral and were able to notice some similarities as



well as many differences. The children enjoyed expanding their knowledge of the geography of our world, as well as learning about the different continents. We are now studying the Anglo Saxons in History.



Year 5 had a brilliant trip to the Liverpool Slavery Museum. We learnt more about the transatlantic slave trade, which supported our English lessons in which we were learning about the real life story of a man named Henry 'Box' Brown who escaped slavering by mailing himself to freedom.
