Dear Parents and Carers

We are really looking forward to welcoming **all children back to school on Thursday 3rd September 2020.** Whilst we know that some families may feel anxious about their children returning we want to reassure you that we have been busy making plans for how we can help to keep everyone as safe and socially distanced as possible. A copy of our **risk assessment** is available on the school website and this shows the many steps that school has taken to ensure this.

To do this we have introduced **staggered start and finish times** for all children please see the document accompanying this letter for a summary of the times for your child's year group. If you have more than one child attending school you should bring, and collect your children at the earliest time.

Eg. If you have a child in F2 and a sibling in Year 6 you should arrive at school at 8.45 to drop off and collect at 3.00. Staff will be on hand to support. Please see below for a summary of the times for each year group:

Please arrive on time to help reduce the number of people on the school site at any one time. Thank you.

Following this letter you will receive separate **guidance notes for each Year Group**, sharing the information parents/carers will need for the new school year, e.g. times, which entrance/exit, what children will need to wear/bring etc.

To avoid the need for children to change into PE kit, we are asking that **children wear** a tracksuit and trainers ONLY on the day they have PE. The relevant day of the week for each year group will be given to you by the class teacher when we return to school in September.
