We have received an update from the Department for Education regarding travelling to school. Please take the time to read and digest their recommendations.

Travelling to school and college safely

It is likely that the roads and public transport system will be busier now that other businesses have reopened. If you live a short distance from your school, walk, cycle or scoot to and from school wherever possible and safe to do so. Avoid sharing a car with anyone outside of your household or support bubble. If you are using public transport to travel to school, don't forget to:

- wear a face covering (unless you are exempt- including if you are 11 and under)
- socially distance where possible
- wash or sanitise your hands regularly
- be considerate to fellow passengers and staff

Please show care and consideration to others at the school gate, at the start and end of the day. I am again requesting that you wait on the yellow footprints outside the school gate. This ensures that there is a clear path along the pavement, so that members of the public and our school can pass safely.
