Gospel Values in our curriculum

Subject: Music

Faithfulness & integrity	Explore the concept of sticking to principles through historical decision-making.
Dignity & Compassion	Emphasise how figures served others and made a difference through love and commitment Significant Individuals (e.g. Florence Nightingale, Rosa Parks). WWII evacuees – Compassion shown by host families to displaced children.
Humility & Gentleness	Florence Nightingale & Mary Seacole – Served others humbly and with care. Compare leadership styles: humble servant leaders vs. powerful rulers.
Truth & Justice	The Suffragettes – Fought for justice and truth in the face of opposition. The Civil Rights Movement (Rosa Parks) – Speaking truth and demanding justice peacefully.
Forgiveness & Mercy	Post-war recovery and the importance of forgiveness and rebuilding relationships. Reflect on times in history when forgiveness was needed.
Purity & Holiness	Saints in History – Look at the lives of saints like St. Francis of Assisi or St. Teresa of Calcutta.
Tolerance & Peace	World War I & II – Lessons from global conflict, efforts toward peace
Service & Sacrifice	World Wars – Soldiers, nurses, and civilians made sacrifices for the good of others. Local Heroes – Acts of service and courage in the face of danger.
